

To all those involved with the licensed vehicle (hackney carriage and private hire) trade in the Preston City Council Licensing area. Independent Trade involvement research to comply with Department for Transport (DfT) Best Practice Guidance document (BPG).

In order that Preston City Council can maintain its present limitation policy of the number of hackney carriage vehicle licences it issues, the Council must carry out a regular survey into the level of service provided by the hackney carriage trade in this area. This is known as an unmet demand survey.

LVSA have been instructed to undertake the 2022 survey. In order for LVSA to understand the current situation we are asking all members of the taxi and private hire trade to respond to this questionnaire. These trade consultations and your specific opinions are important to our review. We need to hear from as many of you as possible in order to take into account your views and experiences of the taxi service as providers of this service to the area. This is your opportunity to express your views to an independent body. All our questions are designed to obtain the responses we need to complete as thorough an investigation as is practicable in assessing what the future might hold for licensed vehicle services in Preston City. If you have recently chosen not to be part of the licensed vehicle trade in the future, or are planning to cease your involvement, we would still like to know your current thoughts. We are particularly interested to speak further with anyone who wishes to give us further detail as to why they have or are planning to leave the industry (please see Q19). If you are aware of others that have not been contacted who have done this, please pass this questionnaire to them.

We are looking for as many completed questionnaires / responses as possible to include in our report.
