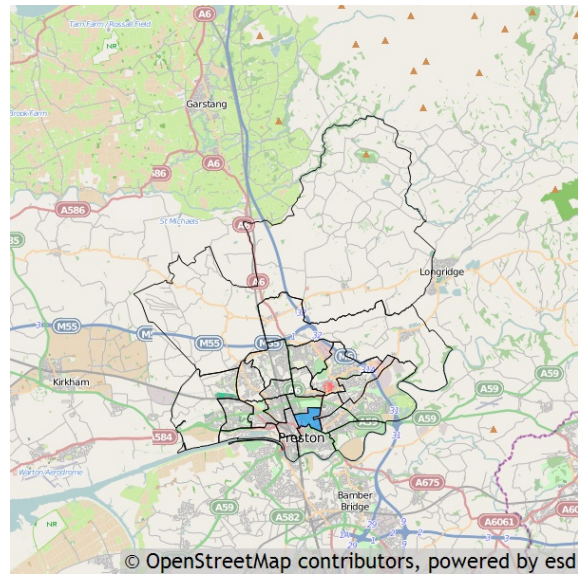


Basic facts about St George's

St George's is one of the 22 wards of Preston. It has an area of 89.16 hectares which represents 0.62% of the total local authority area of Preston.



Residents

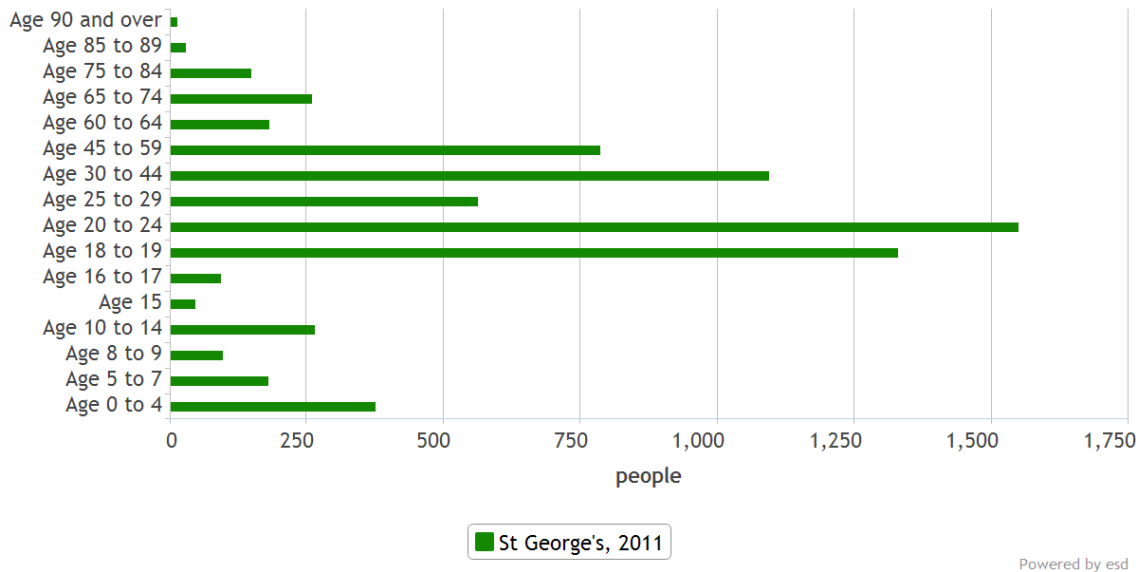
St George's has a resident population of 7,029 which represents 5.01% of the total local authority resident population of 140,202.

Age

The mean age of the St George's population is 29 years which is younger than the mean age of 37 years for residents in the whole local authority. The predominant age band is Age 20 to 24.

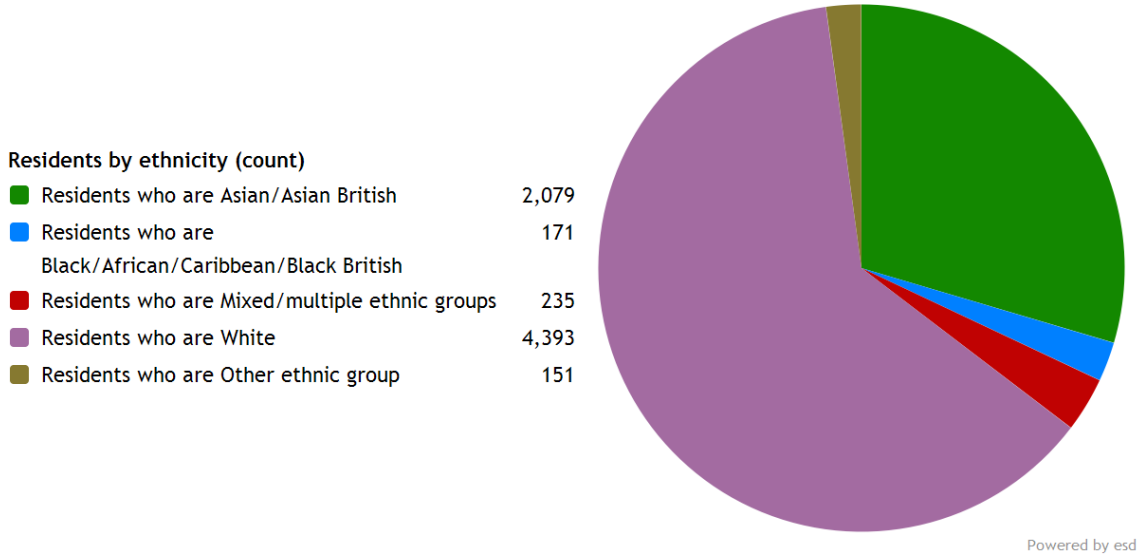


Ethnicity

The largest ethnic group is *Residents who are White* with 62.5% of the ward's population. That compares with 80.2% for the local authority as a whole, 90.2% for North West and 85.4% for the whole of England.

The second largest ethnic group is *Residents who are Asian/Asian British* with 29.6% of the ward's population. That compares with 15.5% for the local authority as a whole, 6.2% for North West and 7.8% for the whole of England.

The ethnic split of St George's's residents is shown below.



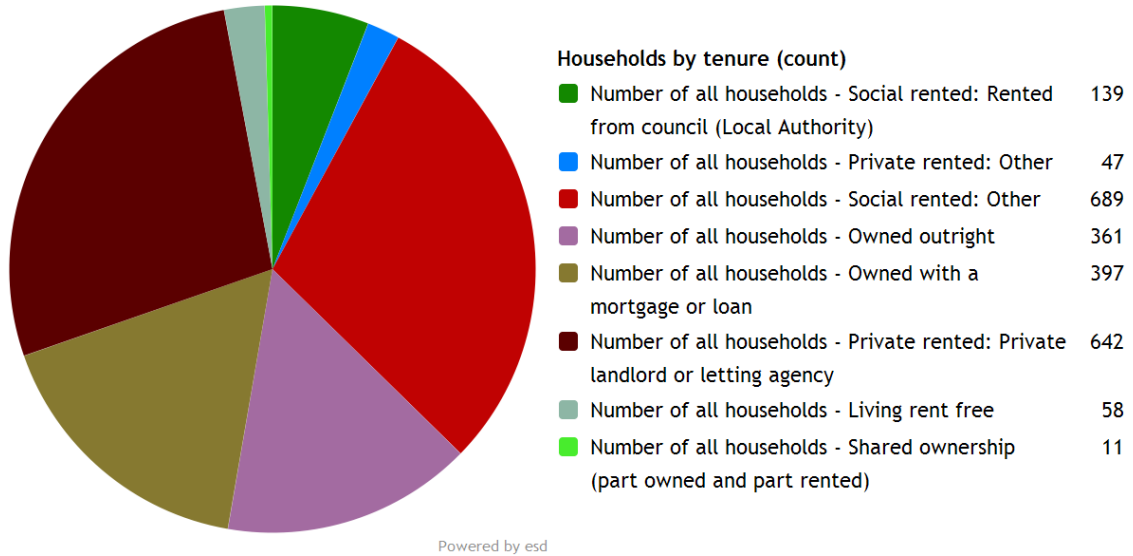
St George's's resident population is 48.7% female and 51.3% male.

The ward has 296 households with **dependent children aged 0 to 4**. That represents 12.63% of the ward's households.

570 households in the ward have **dependent children of all ages**. That represents 24.32% of the ward's households.

Households

St George's has 2,344 households, which represent 4.07% of Preston's 57,567 households. The household split by tenure is shown below.



The largest number of households lives in *Number of all households - Social rented: Other* accommodation with 29.4% of the ward's households. That compares with 15.3% for the local authority as a whole, 8.1% for North West and 5.7% for the whole of England.

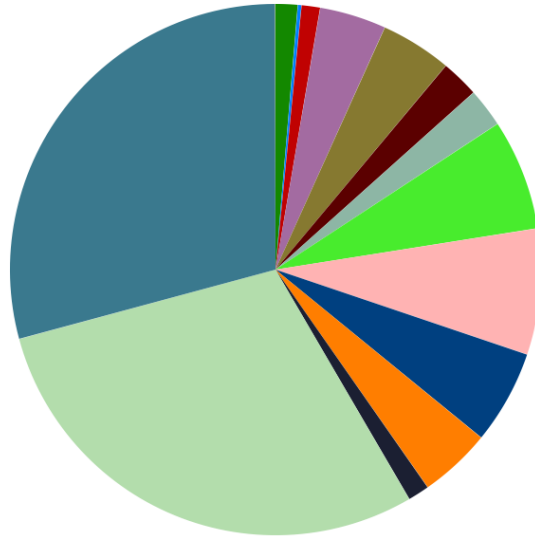
The second largest number of households lives in *Number of all households - Private rented: Private landlord or letting agency* accommodation with 27.4% of the ward's households. That compares with 16.6% for the local authority as a whole, 12.4% for North West and 13.6% for the whole of England.

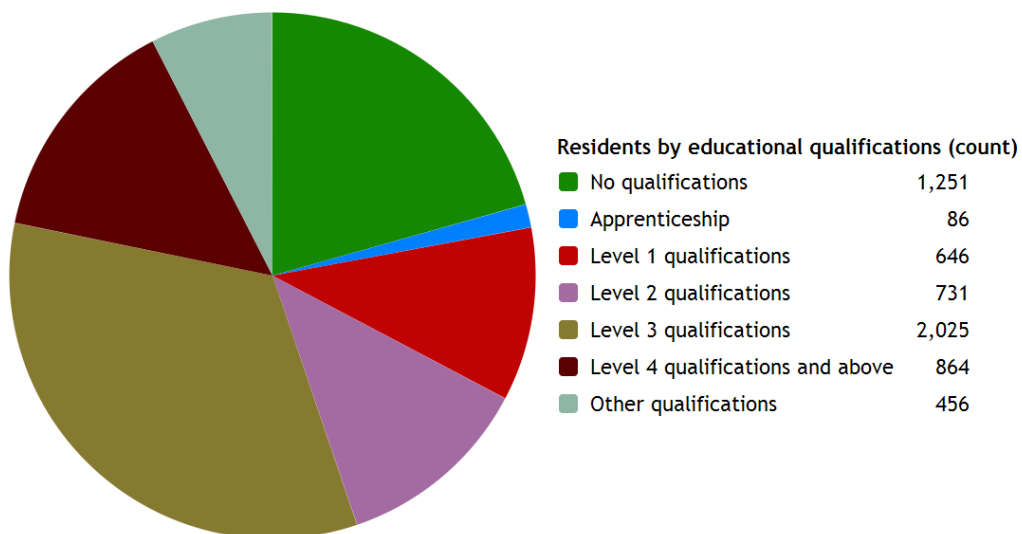

Education



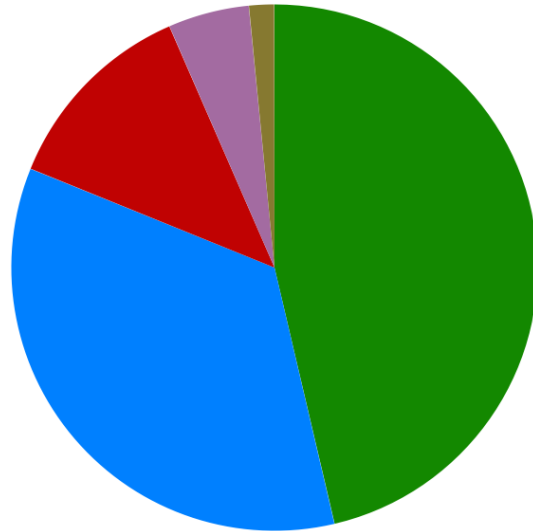

The highest level of educational qualification achieved by the biggest group of St George's residents is Level 3 qualifications, which applies to 33.42%.

St George's has 350 (4.98%) residents in poor health and 109 (1.55%) residents in very bad health.

Its ranking for the number of residents in very bad health is 16 (out of 22) within Preston, 532 (out of 935) within North West, and 5,656 (out of 7,707) within England.
