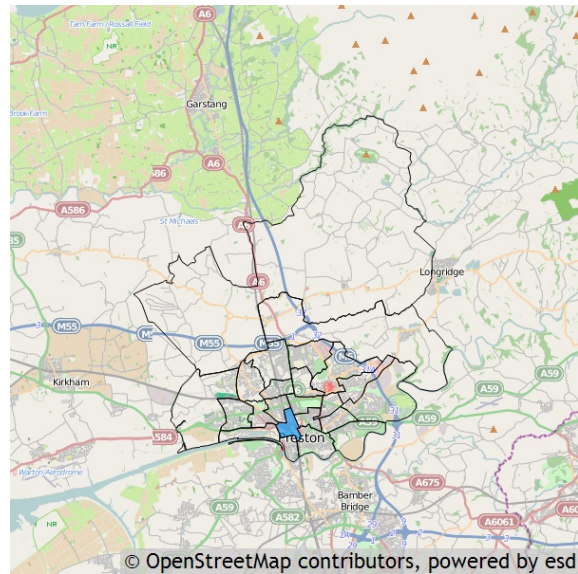


Basic facts about University

University is one of the 22 wards of Preston. It has an area of 96.12 hectares which represents 0.67% of the total local authority area of Preston.



Residents

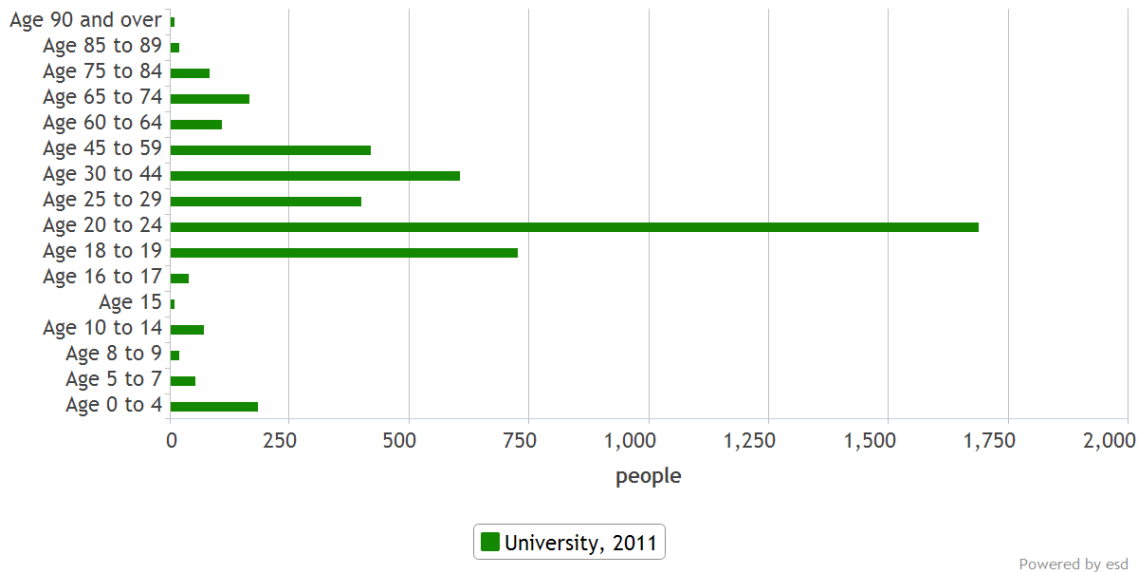
University has a resident population of 4,618 which represents 3.29% of the total local authority resident population of 140,202.

Age

The mean age of the University population is 29 years which is younger than the mean age of 37 years for residents in the whole local authority. The predominant age band is Age 20 to 24.

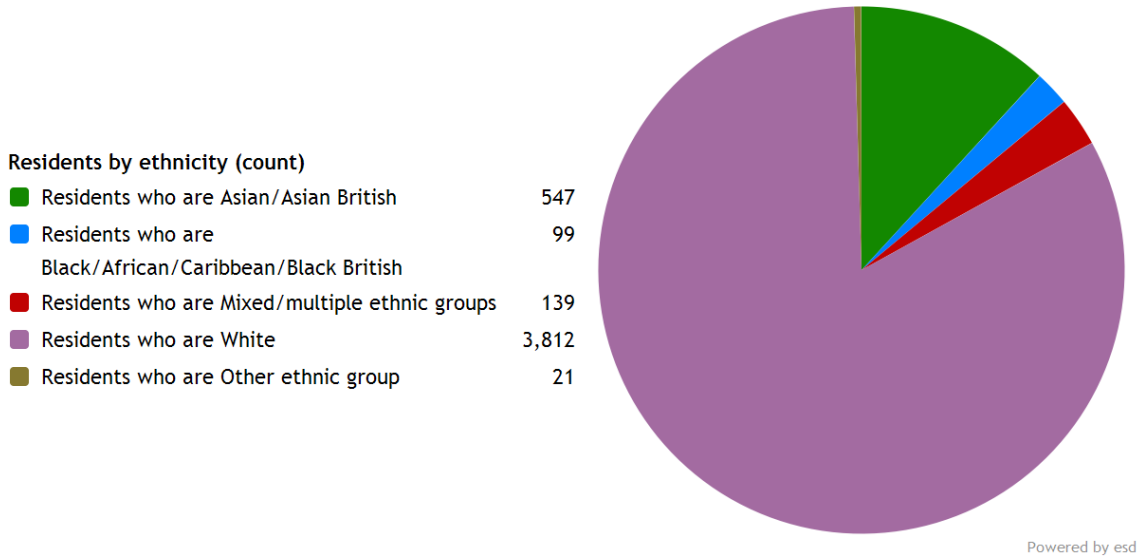


Ethnicity

The largest ethnic group is *Residents who are White* with 82.5% of the ward's population. That compares with 80.2% for the local authority as a whole, 90.2% for North West and 85.4% for the whole of England.

The second largest ethnic group is *Residents who are Asian/Asian British* with 11.8% of the ward's population. That compares with 15.5% for the local authority as a whole, 6.2% for North West and 7.8% for the whole of England.

The ethnic split of University's residents is shown below.



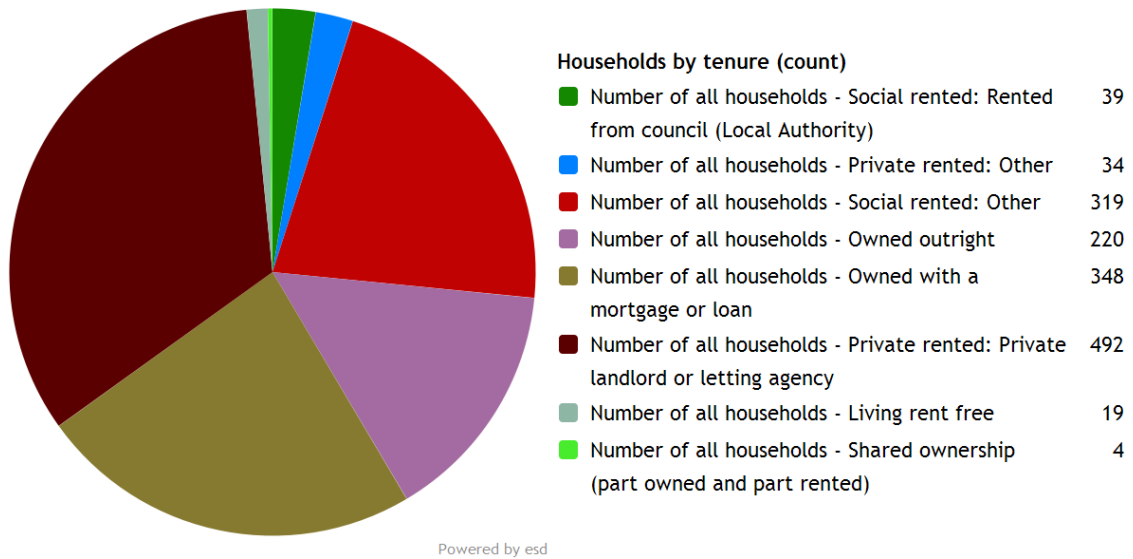
University's resident population is 51.1% female and 48.9% male.

The ward has 141 households with **dependent children aged 0 to 4**. That represents 9.56% of the ward's households.

237 households in the ward have **dependent children of all ages**. That represents 16.07% of the ward's households.

Households

University has 1,475 households, which represent 2.56% of Preston's 57,567 households. The household split by tenure is shown below.



The largest number of households lives in *Number of all households - Private rented: Private landlord or letting agency* accommodation with 33.4% of the ward's households. That compares with 16.6% for the local authority as a whole, 12.4% for North West and 13.6% for the whole of England.

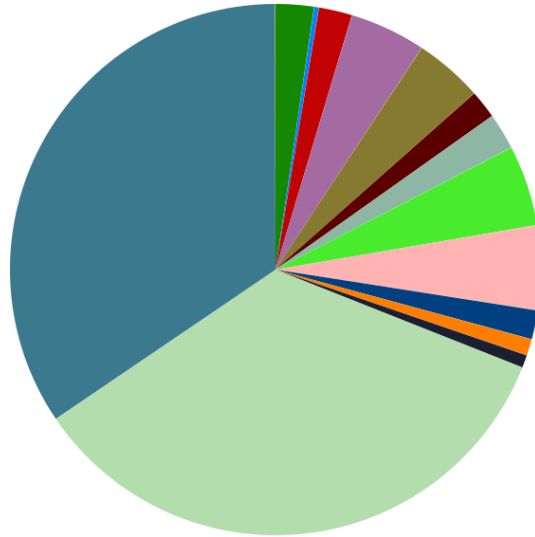
The second largest number of households lives in *Number of all households - Owned with a mortgage or loan* accommodation with 23.6% of the ward's households. That compares with 32.2% for the local authority as a whole, 33.2% for North West and 34.5% for the whole of England.

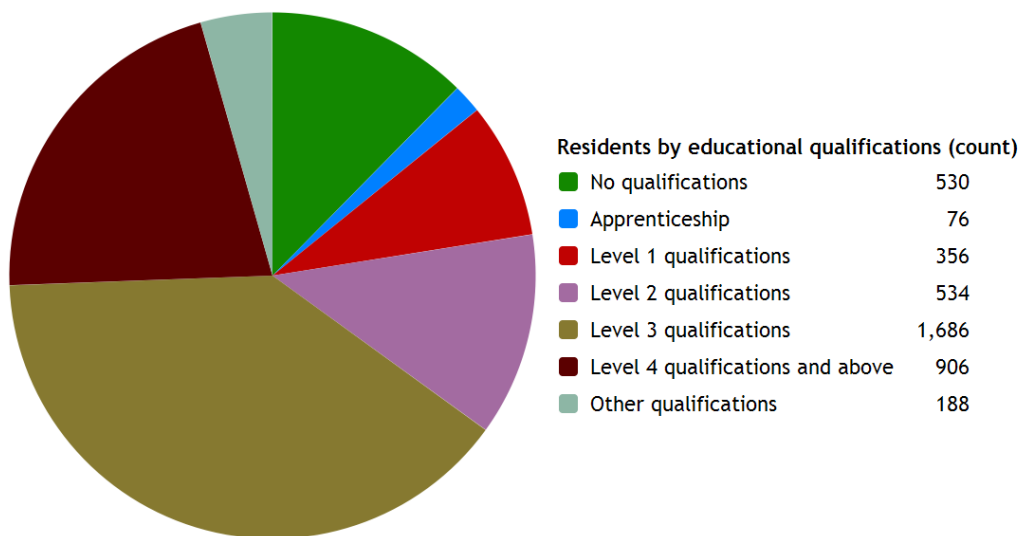

Education



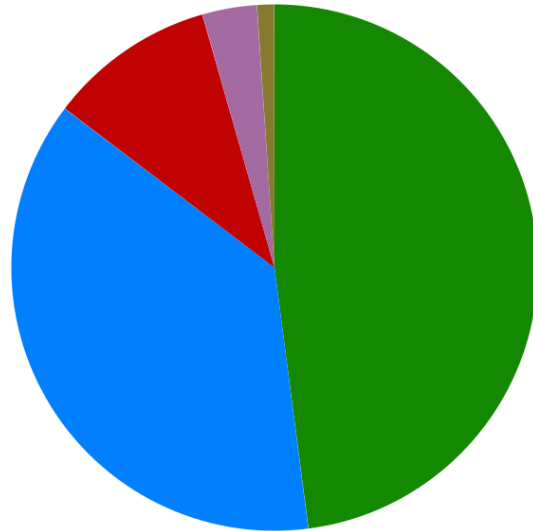

The highest level of educational qualification achieved by the biggest group of University residents is Level 3 qualifications, which applies to 39.43%.

University has 155 (3.36%) residents in poor health and 49 (1.06%) residents in very bad health.

Its ranking for the number of residents in very bad health is 5 (out of 22) within Preston, 265 (out of 935) within North West, and 3,098 (out of 7,707) within England.
