TOWN POLICE CLAUSES ACT 1847, SECTION 21

CITY OF PRESTON (LANCASHIRE ENCOUNTER TORCHLIGHT PROCESSION) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022

WHEREAS

- (1) The Preston City Council is a local authority for the purposes of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847.
- (2) The Council is satisfied that vehicular traffic in the roads specified in this Order should be prohibited in the manner set out in the Order to prevent obstruction of the streets at a time of a public procession, namely the Lancashire Encounter Torchlight Procession.

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of the power contained in Section 21 of the aforesaid Act hereby makes the following Order:-

Commencement and Citation

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 17th day of September 2022 and may be cited as the City of Preston (Lancashire Encounter Torchlight Procession) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2022.

Interpretation

In this Order:-

"the Council" means the Council of the City of Preston;

"the event" means a torchlight procession.

"vehicle" means a goods vehicle, a motorcycle, an invalid carriage, a motor vehicle, any other vehicle of any description whether drawn or propelled along a road by animal or mechanical power or a bicycle, or a tricycle or a cycle having four or more wheels.

3. For the periods specified in the First Schedule to this Order no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform or the Director of Customer Services of the Council or her authorised representative, cause or permit any vehicle other than a vehicle forming part of or otherwise used in connection with the event or an emergency service vehicle to enter, proceed, remain or wait in the length of roads specified in the said First Schedule on the day and between the times specified in the aforesaid First Schedule.

- 4. For the duration of this Order the operation of the Road Traffic Orders specified in the Second Schedule to this Order are suspended to the extent described in that Schedule.
- 5. The prohibition provided by Article 3 of this Order shall not apply if a police constable in uniform or the Director of Customer Services of the Council or her authorised representative determines that the prohibition is not required due to the progress of the event that is to be held on the said road.

THE FIRST SCHEDULE

PROHIBITION OF VEHICLES

(i) Moor Park Avenue

- its full length

The above-mentioned road closure at (i) is required between 12 noon to 10.00 p.m. on Saturday, 17th September 2022.

(ii) Deepdale Road

- its full length

(iii) Sir Tom Finney Way

- from its junction with Deepdale Road to its

junction with Blackpool Road

(iv) Ribbleton Lane

- from its junction with Deepdale Road to its

iunction with Ring Way

(v) Church Street

- its full length

(vi) Ring Way

- at its junction with Church Street

(vii) Birley Street

- from its junction with Church Street to its junction

with Jacson Street

(viii) Lancaster Road

- from its junction with Church Street to its junction

with Ring Way

(ix) Lord Street

- its full length

(x) Tithebarn Street

- its full length

(xi) Ormskirk Road

- its full length

The above-mentioned road closures at (ii) to (xi) are required between 6.30 p.m. to 10.00 p.m. on Saturday, 17th September 2022.

The diversion routes for the above mentioned closures will be via :-

(i) Ribbleton Lane, Ribbleton Avenue, Blackpool Road, Garstang Road, North Road, Ring Way and vice versa.

(ii) New Hall Lane, Blackpool Road, Garstang Road, North Road, Ring Way and vice

versa.

The above-mentioned closures are necessary to prevent obstruction of the streets at a time of public procession.

THE SECOND SCHEDULE

TO SUSPEND THE FOLLOWING ORDERS IN THE WAYS DESCRIBED

1. <u>Borough of Preston ("The Saints" General Improvement Area) Traffic Regulation</u> Order 1982

With reference to Article 2 thereof and the Second Schedule thereto, suspend the one-way provision to the following road and the direction of travel specified in relation thereto -

St. Stephen's Road - West to East (between St. Anthony's Road and Deepdale Road)

2. City of Preston (Various Roads) (One-Way Traffic) Order 2004

With reference to Article 3 therefore and the Schedule thereto, suspend the one-way provision to the following road and the direction of travel specified in relation thereto -

- East to West

Carrol Street

3. <u>The County Borough of Preston (Tithebarn Street and Other Roads) (One-Way</u> Traffic) Order, 1969

With reference to Article 1 thereof and the Schedule thereto, suspend the one-way provision to the following road and direction of travel specified in relation thereto –

Church Row (formerly known as North Road) - North to South (between Church Street and Hammond's Row)

4. <u>The County Borough of Preston (Traffic and Transport Plan Phase I) Traffic Regulation Order, 1973</u>

With reference to Article 1 thereof and the First Schedule thereto, suspend the one-way provision to the following roads and the directions of travel specified in relation thereto –

Derby Street - North to South (between Church Street and Lord's Walk)

Hammond's Row

- East to West

Manchester Road (between Church Street and Queen Street)

- South to North

5. The County Borough of Preston (Traffic Regulation) (Avenham Street) Order, 1960

With reference to Article 1 thereof, suspend the one-way provision to the following road and the direction of travel specified in relation thereto –

Avenham Street

- South to North

6. The County Borough of Preston (Traffic Regulation) Order, 1933

With reference to Article 1 thereof and the Schedule thereto, suspend the one-way provision to the following road and the direction of travel specified in relation thereto-

Glover's Court

- North to South

The above-mentioned suspensions are required between 6.30 p.m. to 10.00 p.m. on Saturday, 17^{th} September 2022.
