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## **Notes**

To be considered for a discount, the term 'prisoner' will include:

- a. Convicted prisoners
- b. Remand prisoners
- c. Those in custody awaiting deportation decisions

- d. Those in custody repatriated from abroad
- e. Those in PRES hostels
- f. Those temporarily released from custody

The term does **not** include:

- i) Those in custody for fine defaulting
- ii) Those in custody for non-payment of the Council Tax
- iii) Those in Police custody before first appearance in court

Before a discount can be granted, the applicant must provide the information in Parts 1 to 4 of the attached form. The completed form should then be returned as soon as possible. Confirmation will be sought from the Prison Service.
