

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER

**TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990
SECTION 257 AND PARAGRAPH 7 OF SCHEDULE 14**

**CITY OF PRESTON (DIVERSION OF PART OF FOOTPATH FULWOOD 6 (6-1-FP 6),
SOUTH OF BLUEBELL WAY, PRESTON EAST) ORDER 2022**

On 02 February 2023 the Preston City Council confirmed the above Order without modification.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to divert the entire width of that part of Footpath Fulwood 6 (6-1-FP 6) from the point where the footpath changes direction to run north from the M6 motorway at point A shown on the order map (Ordnance Survey Grid "OSGR": SD 5695 3255), running north for 215 metres to a point 10 metres north of the warehouse located off Trefoil Way at point B shown on the order map (OSGR: SD 5694 3276), and create an alternative path from the same point where the footpath changes direction to run north from the M6 motorway at point A shown on the order map (OSGR: SD 5695 3255), running generally north north west for 230 metres to an unmarked point on the development site at point C shown on the order map (OSGR: SD 5682 3273), then generally east for 130 metres to the same point 10 metres north of the warehouse located off Trefoil Way at point B shown on the order map (OSGR: SD 5694 3276).

The Order comes into force on the date on which Preston City Council certify that the terms of Article 2 of the Order have been complied with but if any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question its validity or that of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the Order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under section 287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within 6 weeks from the date on which notice is first published as required by paragraph 7 of Schedule 14 to that Act.
