Do you want to ask the Council a Question and get involved in local democracy?



You can apply to ask one question before each full Council meeting.



The right Councillor will answer your Question. After they have answered it you can ask the same person one more on same subject.



If you can't make the meeting itself, the Mayor can ask your question for you.



We will send you a letter with a copy of the reply afterwards.



Sometimes a question may not be allowed but we will let you know why if this is the case.

All you need to do to ask a question is this:-
