



BYELAW

Made under Section 164 of the Public Health Act 1875 by the Council of the Borough of Preston with respect to parks and recreation grounds

The series of byelaws made by the Council on the 7th day of March 1968 and confirmed by the Secretary of State on the 28th day of May, 1968 is hereby amended as follows:-

- In byelaw 5(1)(a) of the aforesaid series the word 'Wheeled' shall be deleted.
- (2) Immediately after byelaw 5(ii) of the aforesaid series there shall be inserted the following wording:-

"Provided that this byelaw shall not be deemed to apply to any area set aside and indicated by notices for the riding of bicycles".

(3) In the byelaw 19 of the aforesaid series for "twenty pounds" there shall be substituted "fifty pounds".
