BYELAWS FOR GOOD RULE AND GOVERNMENT

Byelaws made under section 235 of the Local Government Act 1972 by the Council of Preston for the good rule and government of the City of Preston and for the prevention of suppression of nuisances

GENERAL INTERPRETATION

1. In these byelaws:

"the Council" means the Council of Preston City Council

APPLICATION

2. Byelaw 3 applies to the designated area in Preston shown outlined in black on the plan attached to these byelaws.

TOUTING


- 3. (i) No person shall in any street or public place
 - (a) advertise or solicit custom for any service; or
 - (b) seek to gather information for use in the supply of goods or services;

in such a manner as to cause obstruction or give reasonable grounds for annoyance to any person in that street or public place.

(ii) Byelaw 3(i) does not apply to advertising or soliciting custom for services to hire vehicles to carry passengers.

PENALTY

 Any person offending against Byelaw 3 shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 2 on the standard scale.
