

Properties are usually allocated **1 x grey bin for general waste, 2 x green bins for recycling and a brown bin for garden waste, if required.** To receive garden waste collections you will need to subscribe to our service at www.preston.gov.uk/gardenwaste

If you have no bins, they can be ordered on www.preston.gov.uk/bins (there is a delivery charge per bin). Please note, we may provide a re-conditioned bin.

Bulky Waste

You can also bring your large household items to a Household Waste Recycling Centre (HWRC) run by Lancashire County Council (LCC). This is a **free drop off** point for households.

Shared Drives
Our vehicles and staff do not collect bins from private roads or shared driveways. Please contact us if you have any collection queries.

Asbestos

is hazardous waste and must not be placed in Council bins.

These items can be taken to a HWRC but you will need a permit to bring them. For details contact LCC.

Please use caution when handling.

Alternatively, contact us regarding paid collections.

DIY waste may not go in Council bins. Please bring to a HWRC

Collection Information

- To find your collection day visit www.preston.gov.uk/binday
- Bins must be placed at your collection point by **7AM** on the day of collections and be stored on your property at all other times.
- Missed bins must be reported within 48hrs of the scheduled collection at www.preston.gov.uk/missedbin
- Crews work Monday-Friday every week except Christmas day, Boxing day and New Years day, when alternative arrangements will be made.
- Bins are usually collected fortnightly.
- Put your house number on all your bins.

STATUTORY NOTICE

THIS COMMUNICATION AFFECTS THE HOUSEHOLD WASTE COLLECTION FROM YOUR PROPERTY

PRESTON CITY COUNCIL

ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT 1990 SECTION 46

This Notice supersedes all previous notices issued under the above Provisions.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN to The OCCUPIER/S that: with immediate effect, waste will only be collected by or on behalf of this Council if it is presented in accordance with the terms of this Notice.

PROVISIONS REGARDING THE USE OF RECEPTACLES

Grey bin: general household waste

Green bin (YELLOW LID) / box: plastic, cans, glass bottles *

Green bin (RED LID) / box: paper and cardboard*

Brown Bin: garden waste*

WASTE WILL ONLY BE COLLECTED IF IT IS CORRECTLY PRESENTED IN THE APPROPRIATE BINS.

PROVISIONS RELATING TO THE MAINTENANCE OF RECEPTACLES

To prevent any damage or loss of the bin, please ensure that it is stored within your property line and only left outside in time for the collection service.

The receptacle(s) must be made available for collection by 7.00 a.m. on the day of collection and must not be placed on the highway until after 6.00 pm on the day before the collection.

Any alternative collection points must be pre-approved by Preston City Council.

The Council may seize any bins which are left in public places in order to prevent damage or loss – this could result in a replacement fee being applied.

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS NOTICE

Breaches of the conditions can lead to the interruption of the collection service. Continued breaches which result in nuisance or detriment to the amenities may lead to the issuing of a Fixed Penalty.

All containers provided by the Council for the collection of waste remain the property of the Council. The Council may inspect any waste put into any container and presented for collection.

RIGHT OF APPEAL

If there are genuine reasons why you cannot comply with this notice – please contact the Waste Enforcement Office, Preston City Council, Argyll Road, Preston, PR1 6JY or by telephone on 01772 906905. Written notifications must be delivered within 7 days of the date of issue.

The right of appeal to the Magistrates Court is set out under Section 46(7) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990. No appeal can be made in respect of the use of this notice.

Footnotes:

Replacement wheeled bins may be obtained from the Council on payment of the required delivery charge.

In exceptional circumstances, households may be issued with larger bins for general refuse. This depends on the occupancy of the property and the level of recycling activity. Contact Waste Management at the above address for further advice.

In order to conform to Health and Safety requirements bins obtained from independent sources MUST conform to the required standards. All wheeled bins must have hinged lids and conform to the above colour code and capacity limits. The bin construction should conform to EN840 or RAL GZ951/1 standards. Any bins which do not conform to these specifications will not be emptied by the Council.
