IN PARCELS DIVIDED BY THE SHEET EDGE, THE ACREAGES ARE SHOWN TO SHEET EDGE ONLY.

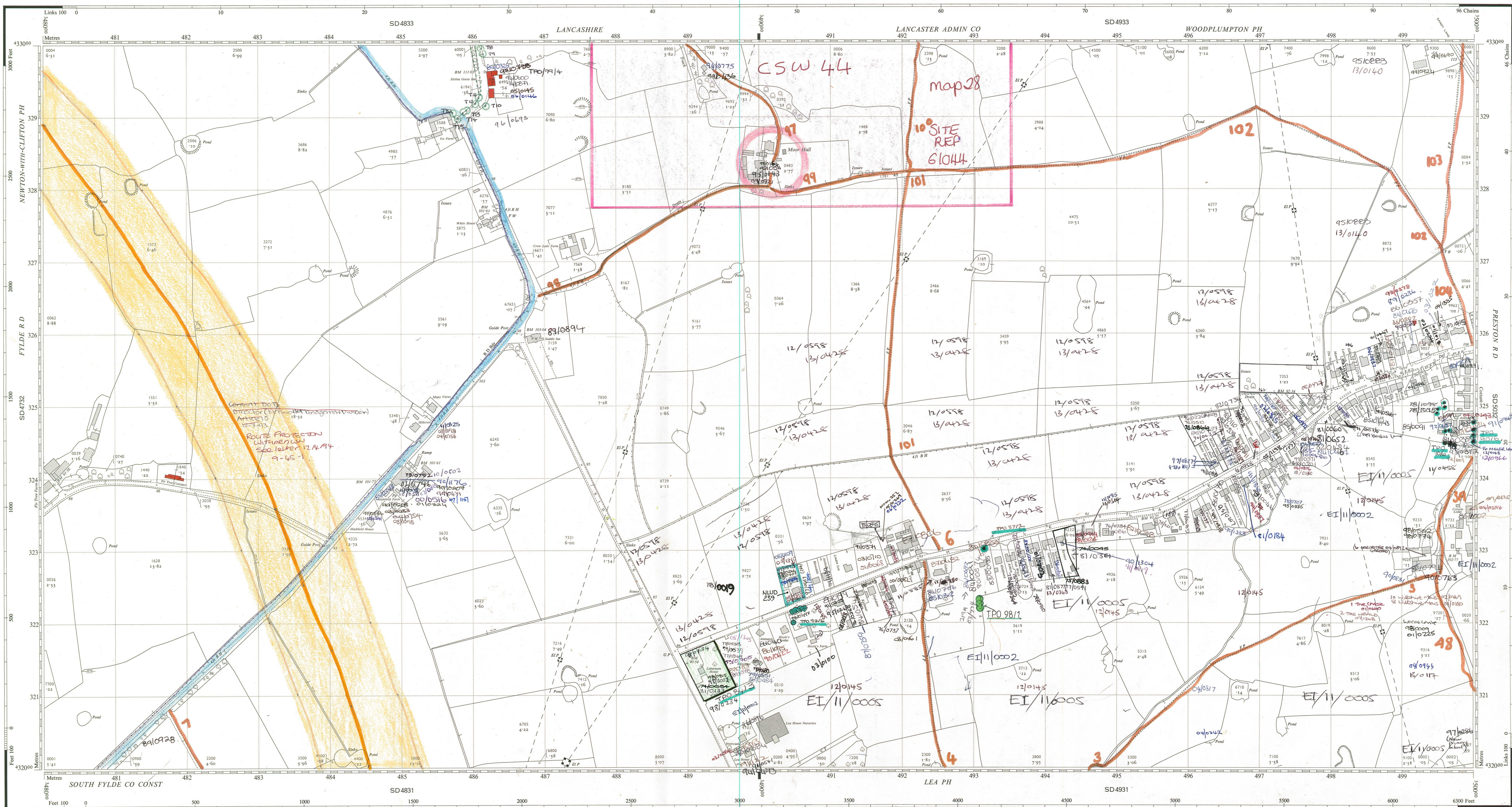
