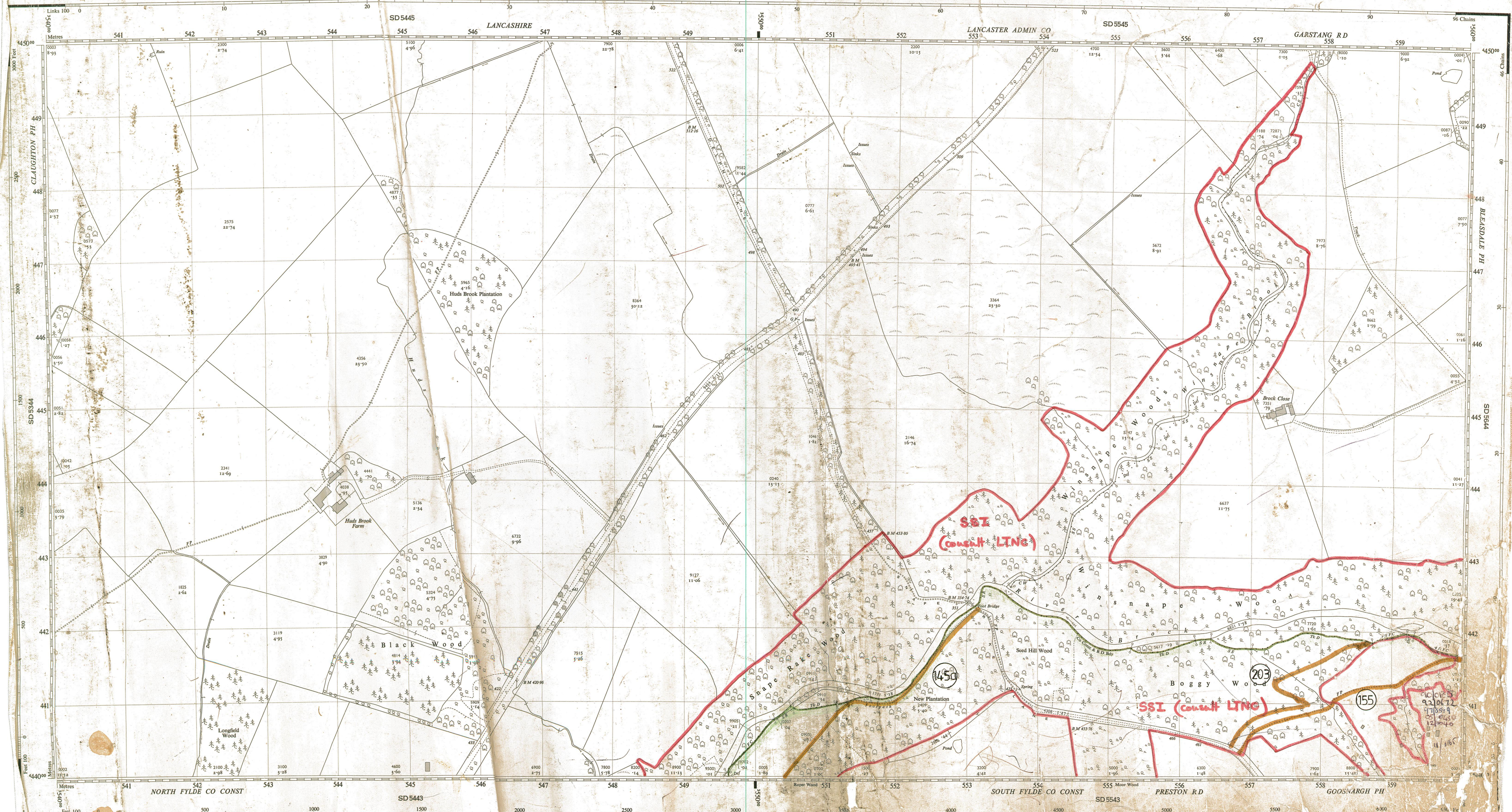

NATIONAL GRID REFERENCE

The lines on the plan form part of the National Grid and are spaced at 100 metre intervals.  
To give a large scale reference the position of a point to the nearest 10 metres (rounded) is followed by the letters 'E' and 'N'.

EXAMPLE: L in Longfield Wood

EASTING	NORTHING
Take west edge of square in which point lies and read the figures opposite this line on NORTH and SOUTH margins	Take south edge of square in which point lies and read the figures opposite this line on EAST and WEST margins
