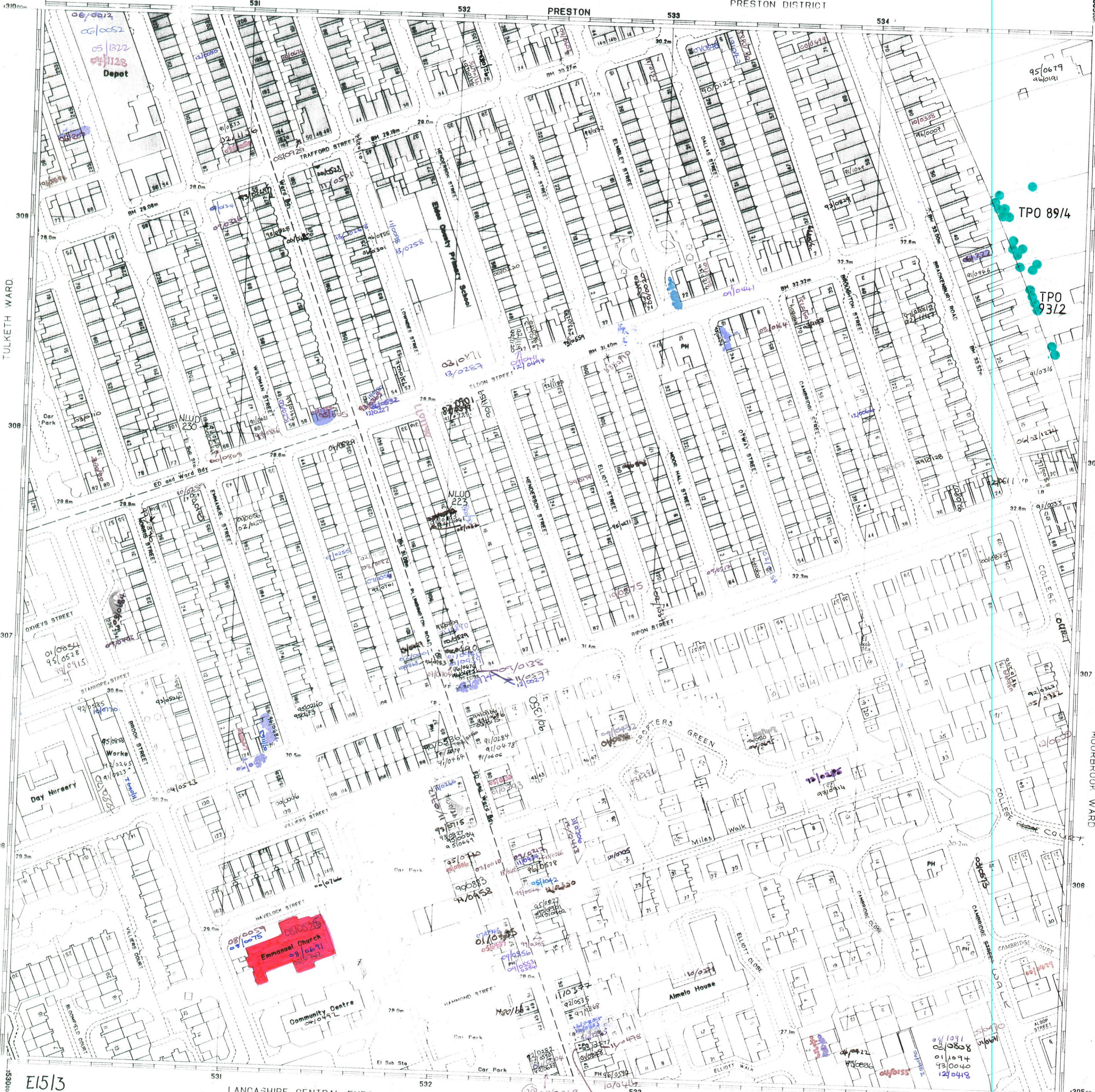

To give a large scale reference defining the position of a point to the nearest 10 metres proceed as follows:-
