**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Preston City Council intends to make the above mentioned Order under sections 32, 33 and 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and in consideration of the provisions of the Road Traffic Act 1991, the Traffic Management Act 2004 and The Civil Enforcement of Parking Contraventions Designation Order 2010 and of all other enabling powers.

The effect of the Order will be to

- (i) introduce a temporary pay and display car park off Tenterfield Street in order to relieve and/or prevent congestion of traffic;
- (ii) enable the Council to enforce effectively regulations introduced by the Traffic Management Act 2004 in the newly created car park;
- (iii) prescribe the charges and the times during which the classes of vehicle specified may use the newly created car park -
