

LICENSING ACT 2003

Preston City Council as the relevant licensing authority, pursuant to section 26B of the Licensing Act 2003, hereby **GIVE NOTICE** that it has received an application for the **variation** of a Premises Licence/Club Premises Certificate from:-

Applicant or club:	Goosnargh Gin Ltd
Address of the premises or club premises:	Eccles Moss Farm, Bleasdale Road, Preston, PR3 2ER
Proposed variation (except in the case of a premises licence where the only variation sought is the inclusion of the alternative licence condition)	The premises are a very small gin distillery which currently sells alcohol by mail order only. The premises run Foraging and Distilling days whereby those in attendance usually no more than six persons, forage in the local forest under supervision of a ranger. These people, using the materials foraged, then make their own gin at the premises. As customers pay a fee to participate and then take their gin away these events have been covered by a Temporary Event Notice. The applicant now seeks to remove Condition 3 in the Crime and Disorder Section of Annexe 3 which disallows the sale of alcohol from the premises to negate the need for TENs. The applicant also intends selling alcohol to the public. These sales will usually be made by appointment.

The register containing a record of the application may be inspected on Monday to Thursday from 8.45 a.m. to 5.30 p.m. and Friday from 8.45 a.m. to 4.30 p.m. at the above-mentioned address. Alternatively it can be viewed on Preston City Council's internet website via our [Public Register page](#).

Any other persons or responsible authority may make representations in respect of the application which must be provided, in writing, to the Licensing Section, Preston City Council, Town Hall, Lancaster Road, Preston, PR1 2RL.
