(GATING ORDER) 2007

The County Council of Lancashire ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under **Section 129A** of the **Highways Act 1980** ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order:-

- No persons, other than the owners, occupiers, statutory undertakers, or emergency services, shall have access to the alleyways ("the Highways") or to keys to the gates restricting access to the Highways known as Back New Hall Lane, Fishwick Parade from Hawarden Road to Devonshire Place and Back Iddesleigh Road, Cavendish Road and Back Church Avenue, Devonshire Place, Preston.
- 2. Alternative routes are proposed as: Via New Hall Lane, Fishwick Parade and Hawarden Road, Downing Street, Cavendish Road, Iddlesleigh Road, Manning Road, Church Avenue or Devonshire Place and vice versa.
- 3. The maintenance and operation of the gates will be the responsibility of the Community Safety Officer, Preston City Council, Town Hall, Lancaster Road, Preston PR1 2RL (contact tel. No. 01772-903417)
- 4. It has been shown that anti-social behaviour and/or crime exists in the area around the Highways and this is exacerbated by the free access to the Highways. The Gating Order would, by limiting access to those persons indicated in Article 1 of this Order, be beneficial in tackling crime and/or anti-social behaviour in the area. The Council is therefore satisfied that the conditions set out in Section 129A(3) of the Act, have been complied with for the purposes of making this Order.
- 5. This Order shall come into force on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2007 and may be cited as the "Lancashire County Council Highways Act 1980 Clean Neighbourhoods And Environment Act 2005 (Back New Hall Lane, Fishwick Parade from Hawarden Road to Devonshire Place and Back Iddesleigh Road, Cavendish Road and Back Church Avenue, Devonshire Place, Preston, Preston City) (Gating Order) 2007.


