

**LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
CLEAN NEIGHBOURHOODS AND ENVIRONMENT ACT 2005
(FISHWICK 2, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY)
(GATING) ORDER 2007**

The County Council of Lancashire, ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under **Section 129A** of the **Highways Act 1980** ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order:-

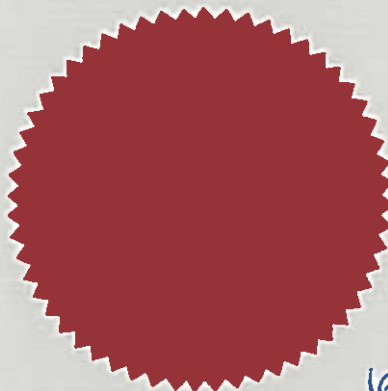

1. No persons, other than the owners, occupiers, statutory undertakers, or emergency services, shall have access to the alleyways (hereafter referred to as "the Highways"), or to keys to the gates restricting access to the Highways to the rear of: - Fishwick Parade, from Fishwick Road to Dundonald Street, 1-5 Fishwick View, Fishwick View from Rutland Street to Dundonald Street, Dundonald Street/Great Townley Street/Nimes Street/Chatsworth Street/Scotforth Road/Annis Street/Rutland Street/Surrey Street/Lex Street, between Fishwick Parade and Fishwick View, and 237-243 Brockholes View, Preston, in the City of Preston.
2. The alternative routes will be via Fishwick Road, Fishwick Parade, Lex Street, Surrey Street, Rutland Street, Annis Street, Scotforth Road, Chatsworth Street, Nimes Street, Great Townley Street or Dundonald Street and vice versa.
3. The maintenance and operation of the gates will be the responsibility of The Director of Environmental Services, Preston City Council, Town Hall, Lancaster Road, Preston PR1 2RL (Contact tel. 01772-906523 Area Renewal Team).
4. It has been shown that anti-social behaviour and/or crime exists in the general area around the alleyway and this is exacerbated by the free access to the lengths of highway referred to above. The Gating Order would, by limiting access to only those persons indicated in Article 1 of this Order, be beneficial in tackling crime and/or anti-social behaviour in the area. The Council is therefore satisfied that the conditions set out in Section 129A(3) of the Act, have been complied with for the purposes of making this Order.

5. This Order shall come into force on the 23rd day of April, 2007 and may be cited as the "Lancashire County Council, Highways Act 1980 Clean Neighbourhoods and Environment Act 2005 (Fishwick 2, Preston, Preston City) (Gating) Order 2007."
