LANCASHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 CLEAN NEIGHBOURHOODS AND ENVIRONMENT ACT 2005 (FISHWICK 4 AREA, PRESTON, PRESTON CITY) (GATING) ORDER 2011

The County Council of Lancashire, ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 129A – 129G of the Highways Act 1980 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order:

- 1. No persons, other than the owners, occupiers, statutory undertakers, or emergency services, shall have access to the alleyways (hereafter referred to as the Highways), or to keys to the gates restricting access to the Highways to the rear of Nos 225-235 Brockholes View and running between Nos 221 and 225 Brockholes View, in the City of Preston. The public rights of way along these Highways is therefore restricted.
- 2. The alternative routes are proposed as via Lex Street, Brockholes View, Fishwick Road, and Fishwick Parade.
- This Order authorises the installation of barriers to enforce the restriction of public rights. The maintenance and operation of the gates will be the responsibility of the Director of Environment, Preston City Council Town Hall, St Paul's Road, Preston, PR1 1PX (Contact tel. 01772 906720 Operational Buildings).
- 4. It has been shown that anti-social behaviour and/or crime exists in the general area around the highways and this is exacerbated by the free access to the lengths of highway referred to above. The Gating Order would, by limiting access to only those persons indicated in Article 1 of this Order, be beneficial in tackling crime and/or anti-social behaviour in the area. The Council is therefore satisfied that the conditions set out in Section 129A (3) of the Act, have been complied with for the purposes of making this Order.
- 5. This Order comes into force on the date below and may be cited as the "Lancashire County Council Highways Act 1980, Clean Neighbourhoods and Environment Act 2005 (Fishwick 4 Area, Preston, Preston City) (Gating) Order 2011".
