

## PRESTON CITY COUNCIL ANNUAL CIL RATE SUMMARY

In accordance with Regulation 121C of the Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) Regulations 2010 as amended, Preston City Council is issuing this 'Annual CIL Rate Summary' effective from 1 January until 31 December 2021.

Preston City Council is a charging authority under the CIL Regulations. Its CIL Charging Schedule took effect on 30 September 2013. The BCIS Index applicable for the year 2013 is 234.

For planning permissions granted in the year 2021, the RICS CIL Index to be applied is 333.
