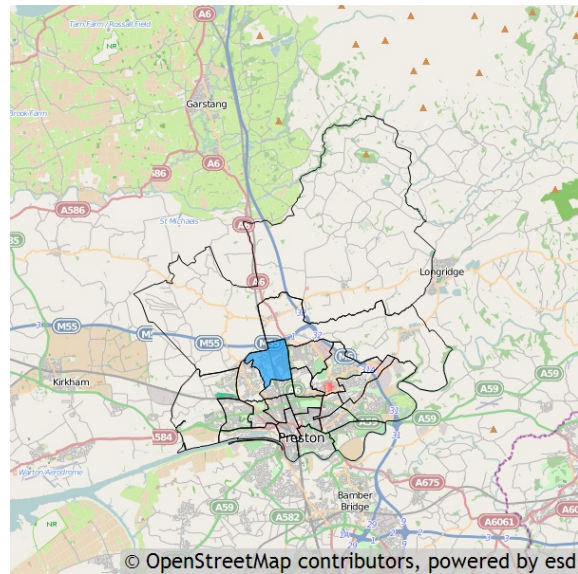


Basic facts about Greyfriars

Greyfriars is one of the 22 wards of Preston. It has an area of 288.26 hectares which represents 2.02% of the total local authority area of Preston.

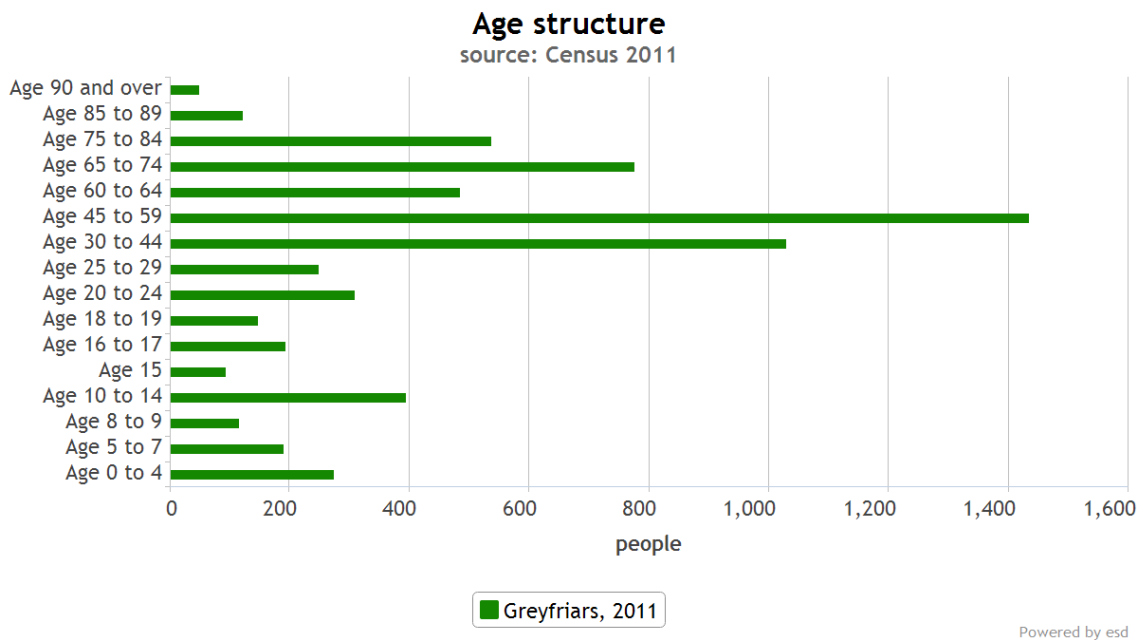


Residents

Greyfriars has a resident population of 6,404 which represents 4.57% of the total local authority resident population of 140,202.

Age

The mean age of the Greyfriars population is 44 years which is older than the mean age of 37 years for residents in the whole local authority. The predominant age band is Age 45 to 59.

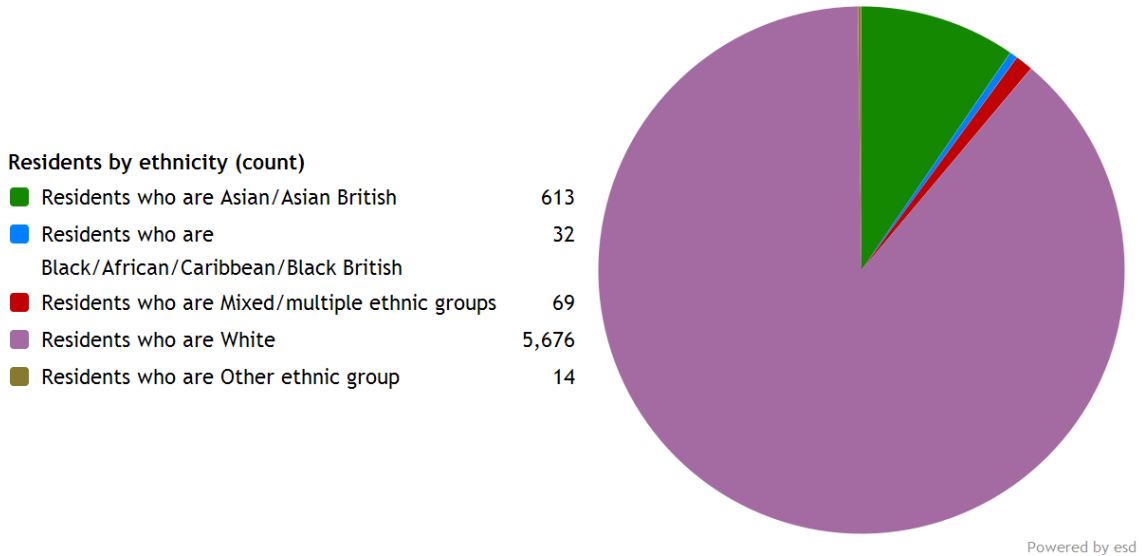


Ethnicity

The largest ethnic group is *Residents who are White* with 88.6% of the ward's population. That compares with 80.2% for the local authority as a whole, 90.2% for North West and 85.4% for the whole of England.

The second largest ethnic group is *Residents who are Asian/Asian British* with 9.6% of the ward's population. That compares with 15.5% for the local authority as a whole, 6.2% for North West and 7.8% for the whole of England.

The ethnic split of Greyfriars's residents is shown below.



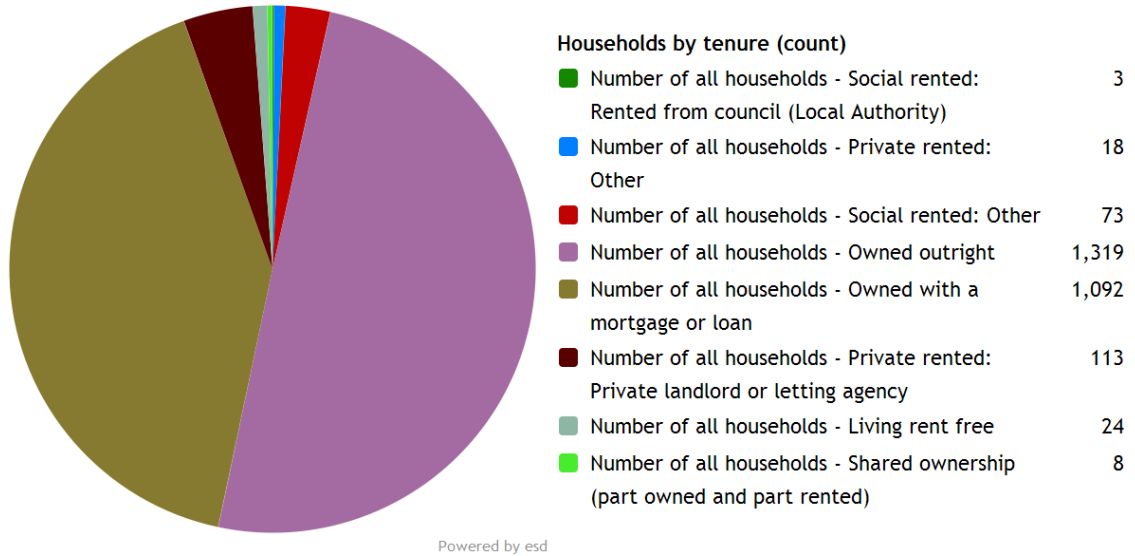
Greyfriars's resident population is 51.8% female and 48.2% male.

The ward has 218 households with **dependent children aged 0 to 4**. That represents 8.23% of the ward's households.

760 households in the ward have **dependent children of all ages**. That represents 28.68% of the ward's households.

Households

Greyfriars has 2,650 households, which represent 4.60% of Preston's 57,567 households. The household split by tenure is shown below.



The largest number of households lives in *Number of all households - Owned outright* accommodation with 49.8% of the ward's households. That compares with 28.4% for the local authority as a whole, 28.6% for North West and 32.8% for the whole of England.

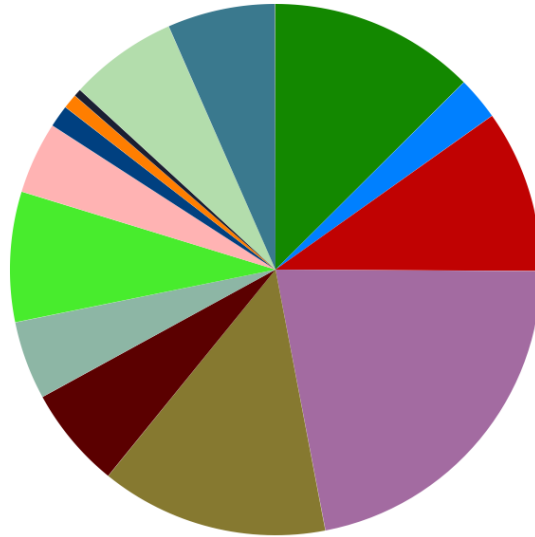
The second largest number of households lives in *Number of all households - Owned with a mortgage or loan* accommodation with 41.2% of the ward's households. That compares with 32.2% for the local authority as a whole, 33.2% for North West and 34.5% for the whole of England.

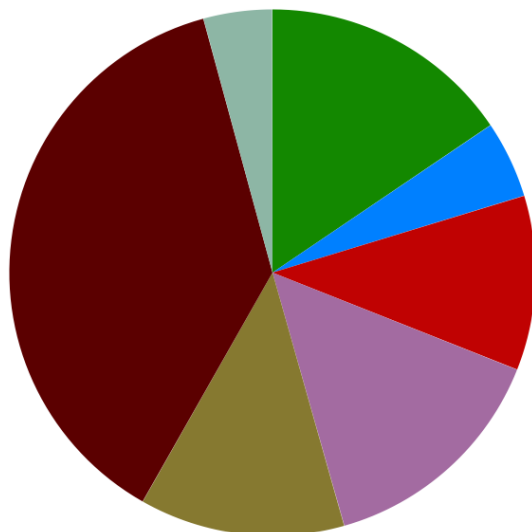

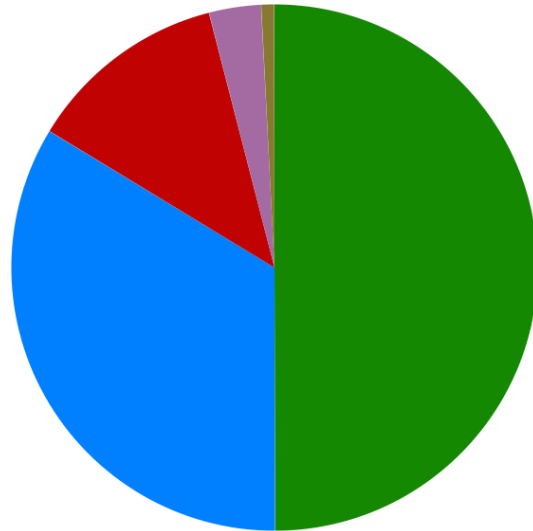

Greyfriars has 205 (3.20%) residents in poor health and 51 (0.80%) residents in very bad health.

Its ranking for the number of residents in very bad health is 6 (out of 22) within Preston, 273 (out of 935) within North West, and 3,221 (out of 7,707) within England.
