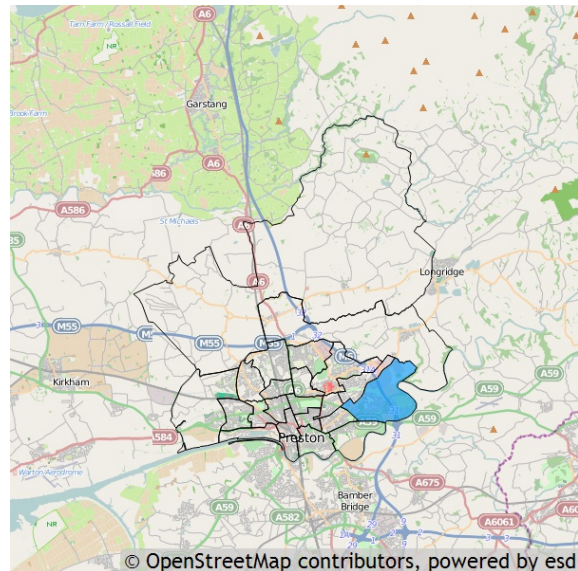


Basic facts about Ribbleton

Ribbleton is one of the 22 wards of Preston. It has an area of 601.50 hectares which represents 4.21% of the total local authority area of Preston.

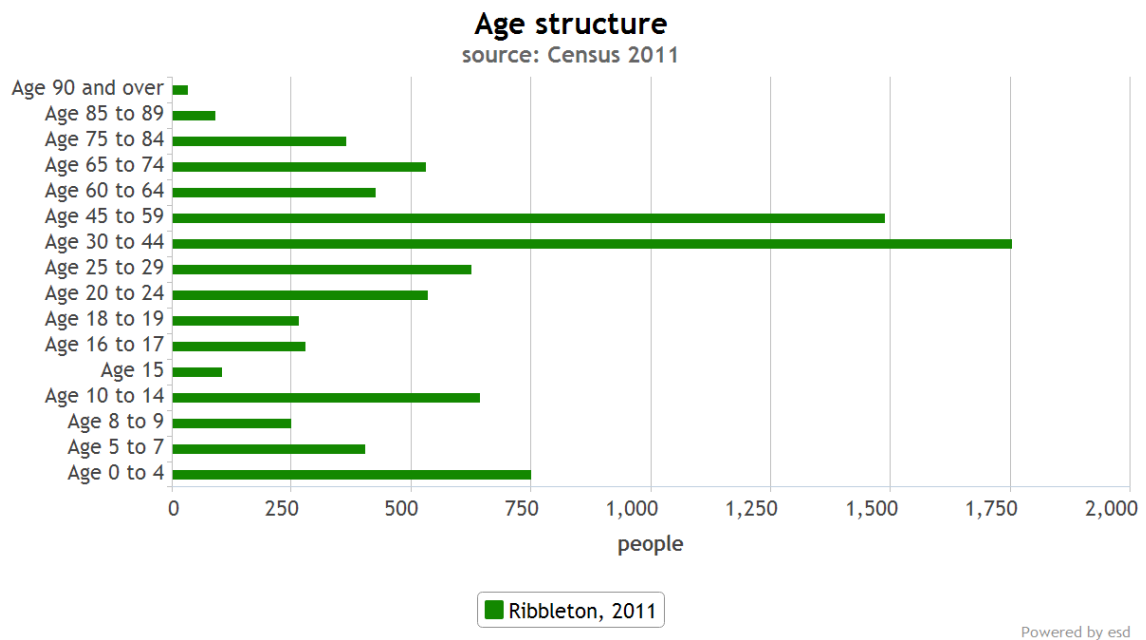


Residents

Ribbleton has a resident population of 8,548 which represents 6.10% of the total local authority resident population of 140,202.

Age

The mean age of the Ribbleton population is 35 years which is younger than the mean age of 37 years for residents in the whole local authority. The predominant age band is Age 30 to 44.

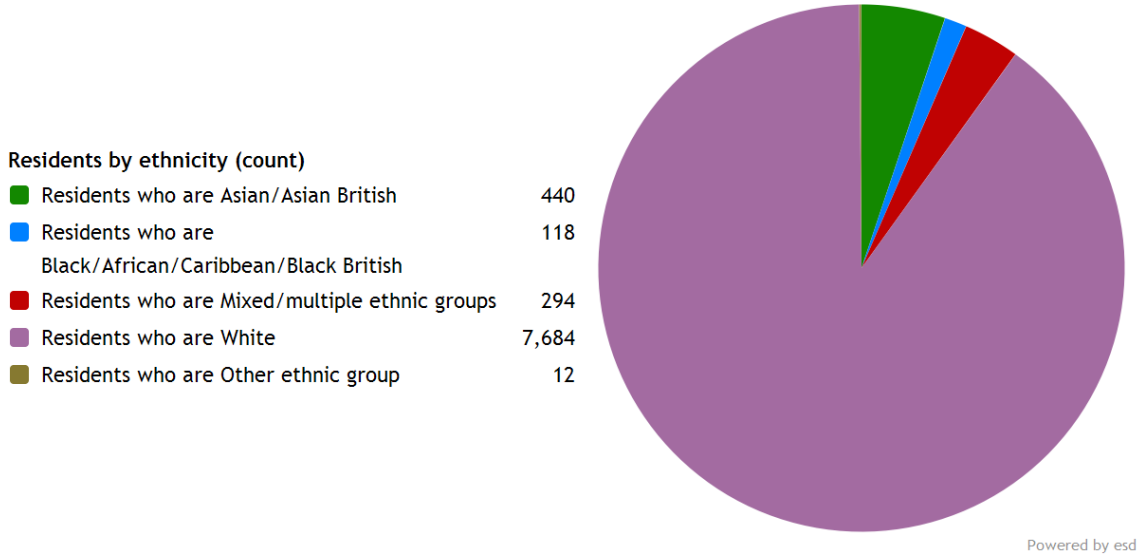


Ethnicity

The largest ethnic group is *Residents who are White* with 89.9% of the ward's population. That compares with 80.2% for the local authority as a whole, 90.2% for North West and 85.4% for the whole of England.

The second largest ethnic group is *Residents who are Asian/Asian British* with 5.1% of the ward's population. That compares with 15.5% for the local authority as a whole, 6.2% for North West and 7.8% for the whole of England.

The ethnic split of Ribbleton's residents is shown below.



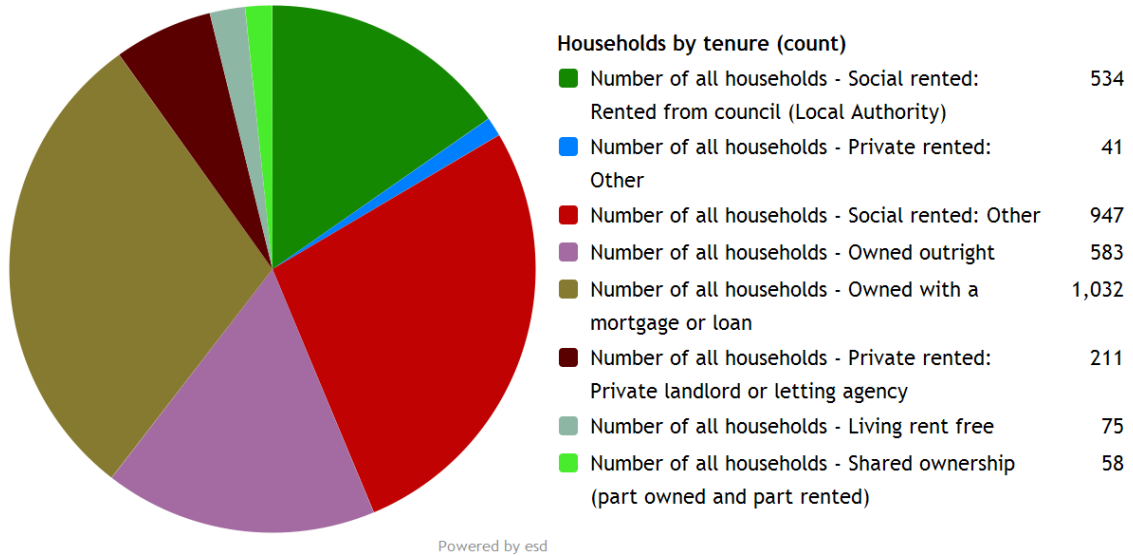
Ribbleton's resident population is 49.8% female and 50.2% male.

The ward has 596 households with **dependent children aged 0 to 4**. That represents 17.12% of the ward's households.

1,253 households in the ward have **dependent children of all ages**. That represents 36.00% of the ward's households.

Households

Ribbleton has 3,481 households, which represent 6.05% of Preston's 57,567 households. The household split by tenure is shown below.



The largest number of households lives in *Number of all households - Owned with a mortgage or loan* accommodation with 29.6% of the ward's households. That compares with 32.2% for the local authority as a whole, 33.2% for North West and 34.5% for the whole of England.

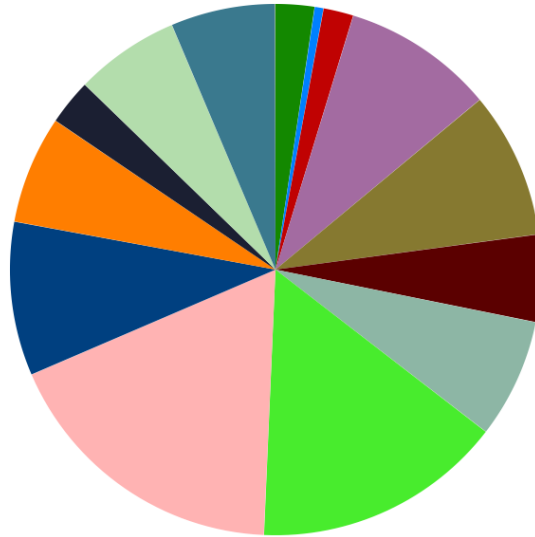
The second largest number of households lives in *Number of all households - Social rented: Other* accommodation with 27.2% of the ward's households. That compares with 15.3% for the local authority as a whole, 8.1% for North West and 5.7% for the whole of England.

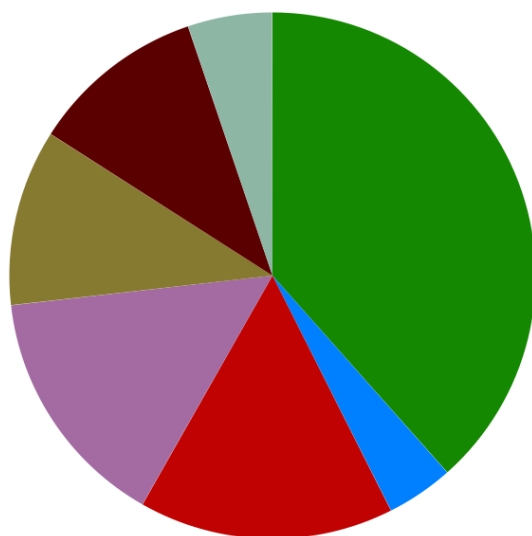

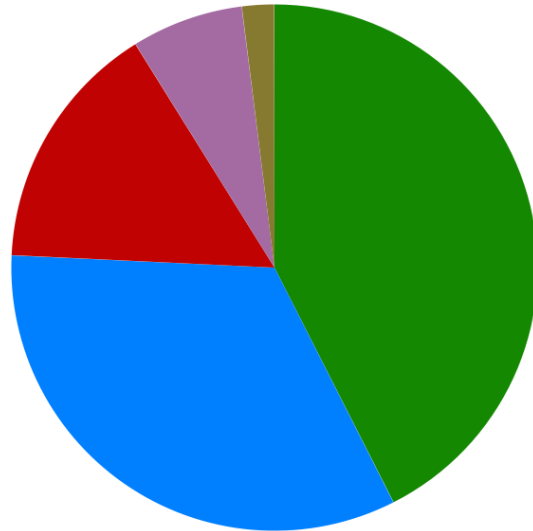

Ribbleton has 588 (6.88%) residents in poor health and 169 (1.98%) residents in very bad health.

Its ranking for the number of residents in very bad health is 22 (out of 22) within Preston, 730 (out of 935) within North West, and 6,667 (out of 7,707) within England.
